MANZANILLA "LA GITANA", HIDALGO, SANLUCAR DE BARRAMEIDA, SPAIN £24.45
125ml Glass £5.75

Spain's number 1 Manzanilla, and it's easy to see why. The ultimate aperitif. Refreshing, with a bouquet that is almost salty, hinting at the smell of a sea breeze. A lively, stylish palate is clean, fresh and vigorous- try with starters and fish dishes.

PEDRO XIMENEZ TRIANA, BODEGAS HIDALGO LA GITANA, SANLUCAR DE BARRAMEIDA, SPAIN £26.95
125ml Glass £6.00

Aromas of raisins, molasses, figs, toffee, caramel, nuts with massive concentration, unsurpassed sweetness and prolonged length. Drink it with (or over!) ice cream, like the Andalusians.

CHAMPAGNE & SPARKLING

CA VITTORIA, BRUT PROSECCO NV, Italy CONEGLIANO VALDOBBIADENE, DOCG £26.95
125 ml Glass £5.95

Forget what you know about sweet Prosecco; this is a beautifully balanced dry wine from high altitude vineyards in the central zone of Prosecco. Fresh, zingy flavor. Notes of yellow apple, pear, white peach and apricot.

GUILLEMINOT "BLANC DE NOIRS", Champagne (DYLAN'S) £39.95
Half Bottle £21.95
125ml Glass £8.00

This grower Champagne is made from 100% from Pinot Noir grapes, giving fruit-led, yet elegant aperitif-style bubbles. Look for fresh, fragrant fruit on the nose; crunchy berry fruit flavours combining with a classic biscuity note and a gentle mousse. Michel Guilleminot also owns all his vines.

NYETIMBER "CLASSIC CUVÉE" 2010, SUSSEX, England £49.95
125ml Glass £11.00

Champagne- who needs it? Was the cry in the 90s. This is our favourite English sparkling wine. Fresh apricot and melon flavours on the palate and lovely tiny bubble texture.

NYETIMBER ROSÉ", SUSSEX, England £59.95

The palate has a creamy, round texture with refreshing redcurrant, raspberry and cherry flavours. Suggestions of brioche lead in to an elegant, silky finish. Brilliant with simple seafood or on its own

Pale gold in colour, with tiny, delicate bubbles. Fresh citrus flavours are balanced with an underlying minerality and a toasty intensity. Very fine and elegant.

POL ROGER EXTRA CUVÉE DE RÉSERVE, Champagne £65.00
Favourite of Winston Churchill, who died exactly 50 years before we opened.
Fresh, racy and consistently fantastic

BILLECART-SALMON BRUT, Champagne £59.50
Deserves the fame of the Rosé- three vintages are blended to make a harmonious, precise and classy Champagne

BILLECART-SALMON BRUT ROSÉ, Champagne £75.00
The rosé is a real delight, with delicate, precise fruit with hints of wild strawberry and an elegant mousse. A fine, distinctive non-vintage rosé.

Fresh Crisp flavours of green apple skin and pear with a tint of citrus and just the slightest touch of fruit sweetness on the palate. Brilliant modern French wine making.

A light floral aroma, and aromatic, an expressive quality, combined with a fresh and cleansing finish. The Aussie version of Pinot Grigio has a little extra weight. They ask for a “glass of pig” in the Lucky Country..

2014 BACCHUS NEW HALL, PURLEIGH, ESSEX £24.95
Bacchus is a deliciously fresh grape, with zesty citrus acidity and pristine orchard fruit flavours. A lovely introduction to how good English wine can be. Off dry and only 10.5% alcohol

FRANCE

2014 MUSCADET SEVRE ET MAINE SUR LIE, SÉLECTION £25.00
DES HAUTS PEMIONS, LOIRE VALLEY, FRANCE
Modern Muscadet; Still fresh and exciting either on its own or with food with a touch of creamy fullness as a counterbalance zippy acidity

2014 SANCERRE, DOMAINE DAULNY, LOIRE, FRANCE £32.95
Sancerre is renowned for its ability to partner fish, salads, quiches, poultry and goat cheese, a specialty of the area. Etienne Daulny is one of our favourite growers.

2011 CHABLIS GRAND CRU BOUGROS, £49.50
J-M BROCARD
A restrained nose of primarily green fruit scents. There is excellent size, weight and power to the solidly well-concentrated wine plus flavors that are robust but not rustic. Jean Marc Brocard is one of France's leading biodynamic and organic growers. Grand Cru Chablis is a "fine wine" bargain.

2013 CHASSAGNE MONTRACHET, £59.50
JEAN-MARC PILLOT, BURGUNDY
Superb- fresh yet full and complex with ageing in new oak giving the distinctive hazelnut nuance of great white Burgundy. Pillot's wines get better and better thanks to his old vines

2014 ALBARIÑO, “BERNON”,
BODEGA AQUITANIA, SPAIN

£27.95

This white, from cool, maritime Galicia in the north-west corner of Spain has a mineral complexity and tremendous elegance. A modish wine at present- this is the best we have found.

AUSTRIA

2013 GRUNER VELTINER,
WEINGUT TÜRK, KREMSTAL

£36.95

This great Veltliner with its bright cheery character and stone fruit aromatics is delicious on its own or with white meats, salads and pasta. Winner of the top prize from Austria's best wine magazine in 2014.

ITALY

2014 GAVI DI GAVI,
MANFREDI, PIEDMONT, ITALY

£29.50

A restrained ripe apple and citrus aroma entices on the nose. A delicious mineral note adds depth and the finish is crisp and fresh. Made from the Cortese grape, and paired locally with delicious Ligurian seafood.

The palate is ripe and rounded with attractive balance – the sweet berry fruit balanced by fresh, juicy acidity on the finish. Carmenere is similar to Merlot, yet unique to Chile.

**2013 JULIÉNAS, DOMAIN DU CLOS DU FIEF,
MICHEL TÊTE, BEAUJOLAIS**

A serious wine from one of the top names in Beaujolais, with structure and texture alongside the juicy, luscious fruit. This great wine even has the potential to age for several years. Powerful fruit, low tannin, so good with cheese, cold meats and pasta.

**2013 SÉGURET "TRADITION",
CÔTES DU RHÔNE VILLAGES**

An estate and a village to watch, made in the shadow of Tour de France mecca Mont Ventoux by expatriate Scotsman Walter McKinley. We love this with our aged steaks and grills. Rich and powerful due to Grenache, Syrah and Carignan, yet with finesse.

2009 CHÂTEAU FOURCAS DUPRÉ, LISTRAC, BORDEAUX

£53.95

A very good château between Moulis and St Julien in the Médoc. Cedar, pine, black cherry and blackberry aromas. Soft tannins of the warm 2009 vintage on the palate, very savoury with chocolate, intermingling with shy black fruit.

**2011 RÉSERVE DE LA COMTESSE,
PAUILLAC, FRANCE**

£74.95

The second wine of Pichon Longueville Comtesse de Lalande offers power and elegance in tandem. Great value for claret of this age and quality.

**2013 MERCUREY 'LA FRAMBOISIÈRE'
DOMAINE FAIVELEY**

£54.00

This single vineyard red burgundy has pure, vibrant aromas of red berry fruits. A fine, poised structure here with bright cherry flavours and a long, complex finish. The best in the village

SANCHO GARCES, SPAIN**

This is proper Rioja, with flavours of fresh, lush berry fruits balanced with very well judged use of oak. Brilliant with grilled meat of any kind

**1996 RIOJA GRAN RESERVA,
BODEGAS BENITO URBINA, SPAIN**

£39.95

Such is the depth and intensity of the wine that it is matured in oak barrels for two years and then a further four years in bottle at the winery before they even consider releasing it. A proportion is also held back for release when it is considered to be at its peak, and that is now. Brilliant, brilliant wine with steak

ITALY

**2009/10 BRUNELLO DI MONTALCINO,
CASTIGLION DEL BOSCO, TUSCANY**

£79.95

Complexity, superb structure, and an inviting, mouth filling palate are the hallmarks of this single vineyard Tuscan classic. A garnet-flecked ruby red, it releases generous, emphatic fragrances classic to Sangiovese, with beautiful balance. Owned by the Ferragamo family, of shoe making and Italian fashion fame

**2009 BARBARESCO, PIO CESARE,
PIEDMONT, ITALY**

£88.95

A very classic Barbaresco, elegant with ripe and spicy fruit, great depth and complexity. Ripeness and finesse, but also strength and opulence from one of Piedmont's great estates. A big, structured wine for red meat.

**2009 PEPPERTREE VINEYARD SHIRAZ, MITCHELL,
CLARE VALLEY, SOUTH AUSTRALIA** £29.95

Ripe, spicy shiraz flavours; dark chocolate with hints of liquorice. The silky mouth coating tannins give a gentle firmness and an elegant structure to a classic Aussie style. Bottle age had given complexity.

**2013 MALBEC RESERVE, GOUGUENHEIM,
MENDOZA, ARGENTINA** £31.95

Deep purple colour with aromas of red fruits, chocolate and coffee beans bursting with red and black cherry flavours and a delicate floral aroma. Warming and powerful. Great with grilled meat

**2014 PINOT NOIR, "PIONERO",
CASABLANCA, CHILE** £24.95

It's always a pleasure to find a new world pinot noir, which actually tastes like a pinot. This delicious example has all the perfume, subtlety and ethereal smokiness that makes pinot noir one of our favourite grapes

**2011 PINOT NOIR, CLAYVIN VINEYARD, MARLBOROUGH, NEW
ZEALAND** £55.00

Enviably complex and structured. Black fruits abound from the glass, with a hint of cedar smoke that is both subtle and delightful. These qualities continue onto the palate, the dark berry fruit and smoky complexity unfurling with great vibrancy. Great wine from a single vineyard of growing fame

Second wine of the great Château Giuraud, made from organic grapes. Perfect balance, which results in an extremely refined sweetness, is given extra freshness by a high proportion of Sauvignon.
- COLLECTOR RESERVE PORT, RAMOS PINTO** £26.00

Ramos Pinto's "Vintage Character" Collector Port is streets ahead of most of the competitor ports on the market. It has a wonderful deep colour and aroma of spiced autumn fruits.

Unusual single estate tawny from the legendary, isolated Quinta da Ervamoira. Lively spicy nose is very rounded and smooth with spicy toffee notes and apple fruit. Clean and intense on the palate with nice length

Pfeiffer are one of only eight wineries to produce this classic "Aussie sticky" which displays floral and raisin fruit and a rich, luscious palate. A classic.

Blandy's 10 year old Malmsey, Madeira
Our grandparents drank plenty of Madeira, and so should we! Rich, dark and complex due to prolonged barrel ageing, yet with a spine of acidity which means that it never cloy.
